

Graduate Survey Report 2019 in December 2019

The metrics selected are **Graduate Employment Rate** and **Graduate Salary Averages**. These 2 metrics were selected as key outcomes of what our students hope to achieve when studying with us. They are also readily available from the benchmarks of NTU and NUS.

Graduation 2019 – 73.3% of graduates were employed within 12 months of graduation

- 100% of local students were employed within 12 months of graduation
- 33.3% of foreign students were employed within 12 months of graduation

Summary

- When comparing Auston 2019 Graduate survey with NUS and NTU graduate survey (Nov 19) it appears that Auston graduates perform similarly to NUS and NTU and in some instances achieve higher salaries compared to NUS NTU graduates.
- Auston Engineering graduates find jobs at **good and similar** levels as NTU and NUS graduates from similar programmes. This finding is consistent with the previous year's report. Mechatronics appears to have a lower employment rate due to the large number of foreign students.
- Auston Engineering graduates earn a **very similar wages when** compared to NTU and NUS graduates from similar programmes. This is a clear improvement from previous years report.
- Computing, although it outperformed NUS/NTU segment is not a subject that auston offers currently and therefore we have excluded it from the review.
- There were no comparable programmes to the MSc in Programme and Project Management from the selected external benchmark institutions.
